

## Getting to Batsford by Public Transport.



However you choose to get to Batsford, there are plenty of links which means you don't have to resort to using the car – better for the wallet and the environment.

### **By Bus:**

There are regular buses to Moreton from Cheltenham (service 801 Pulham's Coaches) and the 21 and 22 Johnsons Excelbus services from Stratford Upon Avon drop passengers at the end of our drive. The service takes about 5 minutes but bear in mind you'll have to walk up the mile long drive.

### **Walking:**

You can walk from Moreton-in-Marsh via the Monarch's Way (about 1.7 miles). This picturesque footpath takes around 35 minutes and brings you right up to the Arboretum.

### **By train:**

First Great Western operates train services between London Paddington and Evesham, Worcester and Hereford via Oxford and Moreton-in-Marsh (about 1 hour 40 minutes from London to Moreton). Local taxis often meet the London trains but it may be better to book in advance. There's more information about taxi companies on our website and you can expect to pay around £5 each way for a taxi.
